

Red Cross Babysitter Course

The purpose of this American Red Cross Babysitter course is to provide youth who are planning to babysit with the knowledge and skills necessary to safely and responsibly give care for children and infants. This training will help participants to develop leadership skills, learn how to develop a babysitting business, keep themselves and others safe and help children behave, and learn about basic child care and basic first aid. There are no prerequisites required to take the course. Included in the price of the course is a training kit. The contents of the kit include:

- Babysitter's Training Handbook- This full color handbook is filled with great information and resources to use in class and on the job.
- Babysitter's Training Emergency Reference Guide- This easy-to-carry, compact booklet provides step-by-step instructions to handle common emergencies such as bee stings and asthma attacks.

ACADEMIC COURSES FOR CREDIT

Our summer academic program allows students the opportunity to earn high school credits in order to have more room in their schedule for other courses during the regular school year.

Geometry

This class is a fast-paced, accelerated Geometry course covering a full year of material in a four-week period. This course is designed to emphasize the study of the properties and applications of common geometric figures in two and three dimensions. Geometric relationships will be explored using traditional geometric tools to perform constructions and measure figures. Inductive and deductive thinking skills are used in solving real-world applications and proving properties of parallel and perpendicular lines, triangles, and polygons. Algebra skills are applied extensively with area, surface area, and volume formulas as well as the Pythagorean Theorem and basic Trigonometry.
